Starting in September, we hope for a return to two services: 9 a.m. and 11:15 a.m. Snow birds and those who go to summer cottages are welcome. If you let us know of your time away, we will NOT schedule you on those Sundays. Welcoming our visitors takes about 20 minutes – 5 minutes before the service and about 15 minutes after. The only requirements are a smiling face and a willingness to chat with visitors. It is a pleasant and broadening experience. Extra safety measures will be taken during the coronavirus time.
