We Are Looking For Welcome Center Volunteers: When it is safe to gather again for worship, there will be need of additional Welcome Center volunteers. Scheduling is done in advance by calendar quarter. A reminder post card is sent prior to the Sunday one is helping. Starting in September, we hope for a return to two services: 9 a.m. and 11:15 a.m. Snow birds and those who go to summer cottages are welcome. If you let us know of your time away, we will NOT schedule you on those Sundays. Welcoming our visitors takes about 20 minutes – 5 minutes before the service and about 15 minutes after. All ages from teenagers to senior citizens can participate. In the past, 2 teens have worked together as a welcoming team. The only requirements are a smiling face and a willingness to chat with visitors. It is a pleasant and broadening experience. Extra safety measures will be taken during the coronavirus time. Worship is central to our life together at CLC and we are overjoyed to be coming together in a new way: worship in our parking lot by FM radio! Who would have thought this would be the case just a few months ago? To help us park, worship, and exit in a coordinated fashion, we offer the following points to help describe our time together on June 21:

- The service will be uploaded on our website as a PDF. Please download the file ahead of time on your mobile devices. It will also be emailed to you on Friday.
- Only the 44th Street entrance will be open on the North side of the parking lot.
- As you enter the parking lot, a greeter will direct you to parking attendants who will direct you to your parking place for the service. Cars will be parked using every other space.
- If you need a paper bulletin for the service, ask the greeter or put your hand out your car window after you park and one will be delivered to you.
- Please remain in your vehicle for the service. We will have the right FM station posted closer to the day of the service.
- We can cheer, sing, and pray our way through “Christ at the Corner” worship!
- After the service, a parking attendant will indicate when it is your vehicle’s turn to leave.
- The greeter will have a basket available for offerings as you exit onto 44th Street.
- One bathroom will be open in case of emergency need. Walk over to the side door by the education wing and the greeter will assist you in entering the building. Masks must be worn and children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Special cleaning will be arranged.
