Cycling For Multiple Sclerosis (MS): Dave Harris will be bicycling his 20th year to raise money for the fight against MS. The event is happening June 1 - 2 in the West Michigan Great Lakes Breakaway, and organized by the Michigan chapter of the MS Society. While the main route is 75 miles each day, Dave once again hopes to ride the optional 100 mile route if he meets his fundraising goal of \$1,500.00. He has successfully completed the 200 miles every year since 2006. Over 18,000 people in Michigan alone live with this debilitating disease.
